**RE: AUSTRALIAN UNIVERSITY GAMES CYCLING CHAMPIONSHIPS 26 – 28 SEP 2017**

Australian University Sport will be hosting the 2017 Australian University Games Cycling Championships from 26-28 September 2017 in the Tweed Shire near Murwillumbah. Approvals have been sought from Tweed Shire Council and Tweed Heads Highway Patrol to conduct the event. We would like to take this opportunity to advise you about the event.

The Australian University Games is an annual event now in its 25th year held for university students across Australia to compete against the best in the sector. The Cycling element has been held in the Tweed Shire region every second year dating back to 2007 and the cycling routes to be used are those used regularly by the Murwillumbah Cycling Club. The event is being run once again in conjunction with the Murwillumbah Cycling Club with club member Dennis Burger contracted as Competition Manager.

Please note that **no roads will be closed for the event** however traffic management and marshals will be in place to ensure the safety of cyclists at particular intersections along the route.

<b>Event dates/details</b>	26 Sep 2017: Road race events (men and women) 27 Sep 2017: Team Time Trial (men and women) 28 Sep 2017: Individual Time Trial (men and women)
<b>Hours of Operation</b>	Race times will be between 09:00 and 12:00.
<b>Participants</b>	Participants: Approximately 55 men and 35 women per day. No spectators.
<b>Location</b>	The start/finish line for the races will be at corner of Dulguigan Rd and Urliup Rd, Murwillumbah (as per Murwillumbah Cycling Club races).
<b>Traffic Management</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Roads will remain open to traffic during the event, with signage and traffic management personnel managing key intersections. Additional marshals will be in place to assist cyclists safely along the route and to highlight turnaround points. These marshals will <u>not</u> be directing traffic.</li> <li>Lead and tail vehicles will be used for each event and will operate flashing orange lights and warning signs to notify vehicles that a cycle event is in progress.</li> </ul>

Australian University Sport would like to take this time to thank you for your patience and understanding in advance should the event impact you or your business in any way. We would also like to ask you to exercise caution when driving along roads at this time to help us protect the safety of participants. We will do all we can to ensure the impact of the event is minimised.

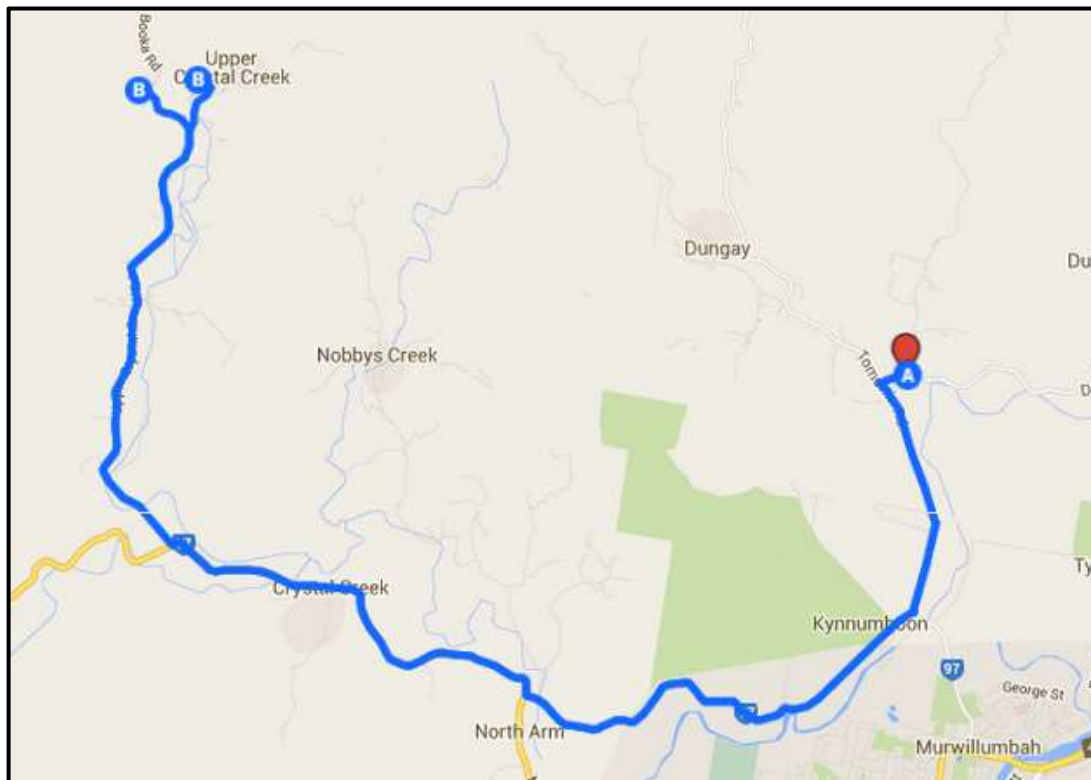
